Every year Whiteley Homes Trust offers businesses and groups opportunities to become involved with our beautiful Village.

Built at the turn of the last century, Whiteley Village is set in 225 acres of stunning Surrey woodland and comprises 262 Grade II listed almshouses, a care home and extra care apartments for nearly 500 older people of limited means.

The Trust's vision is to make Whiteley Village **"One of the best places to age in Britain"** and to achieve this we have a dedicated team of staff and volunteers to maintain the special surroundings throughout the year.

- **Helping to maintain the Grade II listed buildings by undertaking light maintenance tasks like tidying and painting**

- **Hosting tea parties and events for residents**
- **Assisting residents set up for Village events like the annual Village Fayre and Christmas Party**
