The Whiteley Foundation for Ageing Well is being established as part of the centenary celebrations of Whiteley Village. The Foundation will have three main functions. It will:

1. Identify innovative initiatives and ideas that could help older people age well, listening to the voices of older people themselves and thought-leaders in the field. These may be found in the UK or abroad, and in a wide variety of organisations.
2. Help Whiteley villagers and the Whiteley Homes Trust select those that are likely to bring greatest benefit to older people, and establish evidenced-based projects to assess their impact. This is likely to include establishing partnerships with organisations, such as universities or commercial enterprises, that wish to participate in trials.
3. Share the results widely, developing a number of platforms and involving older people in giving the messages, so other organisations and people can benefit from our experience.

This concept has the support of HRH The Prince of Wales, Surrey University, Age UK and the Almshouse Association. The Foundation has, to date, been sponsored by an anonymous donor, the Worshipful Company of Drapers and the Pargiter Trust.
